## Dear Parents,

you want to see your children getting the best possible opportunities for their development and education. The childcare centre wants to make this possible.

For this reason we participate in the process of quality development for protestant child day-care facilities. This is a systematic approach that is currently introduced in all day-care facilities for children run by the protestant church in Hesse and Nassau (EKHN).

**This aims on securing the high quality-standard of the work that is offered in the facilities and develop this even further.**

We want to see firm standards marking the end of this quality development process.

## Quality development – how does this work?

Quality development means continuous control of ones own work in order to develop improved performance. In order to achieve this, 25 tasks of day-to-day performance are investigated. One of the areas in question is the cooperation with you as parents – we consider this as crucial for supporting and promoting your child in his or her development.

In order to investigate the quality standards the teams use an evaluation sheet that allows them to find the potential of furthering the development of the work. It is possible to define certain focal points and select specific areas in which quality can be increased.

**Ask in the centre your child visits which areas and projects had been defined by the team as pertinent for quality development.**
